#### Minutes of Council Meeting Buchanan, VA

December 14, 2020

<u>Present:</u> Mayor Craig Bryant

Vice-Mayor James Manspile Councilman John Mays Councilman Marlon Rickman Councilman Christopher Witt

Mayor Craig Bryant called the December 2020 Council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Buchanan Theater. Town Clerk Jenny Petty took roll call with all Council members present. A moment of silence was held and all that were present stated the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item of business was to consider approval of the November 2020 Financial Report, unpaid bills and approval of the Council minutes from the regular meeting held on October 15, 2019. Mayor Craig Bryant asked for discussion. A motion of approval for all items under consent agenda was made from Vice Mayor James Manspile. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Marlon Rickman. The motion was passed with a vote of 5-0.

Next on the agenda was Awards, Recognitions and Presentations. The Price Family Award was presented to Gavin Price and his family for the exceptional job of collecting 1400 jars of peanut butter to support the Backpack Buddy program. John Mays was given a plaque to thank him for his time served on Town Council. Councilmember Mays stated that he enjoyed serving the town. Mayor Craig Bryant recognized the town as a whole for Senator mark Warner's letter to the town proclaiming the Town of Buchanan a Tree City USA for the 13<sup>th</sup> year in a row. Clerk of the Court Tommy Moore then swore in Mayor Bryant, Vice Mayor James Manspile and new councilmember Chris Petty to council. After the swearing in, Mayor Craig Bryant stated that a Council Retreat would happen the first weekend of January where councilmembers would meet with the town attorney and Town Manager to set the goals, review the budget, select committees and go over rules and regulations for council.

Next on the agenda was to hear citizen comments and petitions regarding agenda items. No citizens had signed up to speak.

Next on the agenda was New Business/Action Items/Public Hearings. First was consideration of Resolution #R20-1214-01 Establish TODS Grant. Councilmember John Mays stated that this grant would

allow tourist businesses to receive reimbursement for interstate 81 signage if certain criteria is met. Vice Mayor James Manspile made a motion to accept with a second from Councilmember John Mays. Motion carried with a vote of 5-0. Next was consideration of Resolution #R20-1214-02 HVAC upgrades at the Buchanan Fire Station. Town Manager Jason Tyree stated that the system was in need of repair and that Botetourt County will pay for it as it is covered under the CARES Act. A motion to accept was given by Vice Mayor James Manspile with a second from Councilmember Marlon Rickman. Motion carried with a vote of 5-0. Next was consideration on Resolution #R20-1214-03 Purchase of a pump for the Water Street Lift Station. Town Manager Jason Tyree stated that the pump and motor were sent off for repair but could not be repaired. Several quotes were gotten to purchase. Vice Mayor James Manspile spoke to the manufacturer giving them the tag number off of the existing pump and was able to get the best price to purchase straight from them. A motion to accept was made by Councilmember John Mays with a second from Councilmember Marlon Rickman. Motion carried with a vote of 4-0 with Vice Mayor James Manspile abstaining. Next was a CARES Act update from Town Manager Jason Tyree. So far, \$10,000.00 in funding has been obtained for a heated pressure washer, masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, had sanitizer stations, etc. Also falling under the CARES Act funding totaling \$6,627.82 will be used for Utility Bill relief for customers that are 60 days delinquent. Town Manager Jason Tyree asked for a waive of late charges and cut-off's for December 2020 due to this relief coming and that some customers did not receive their bills due to high mail volume for the holidays. A motion to accept a verbal resolution was made by Vice Mayor James Manspile with a second from Marlon Rickman. Motion carried with a vote of 5-0. Town Manager Jason Tyree also brought it to the Council's attention that the 2021 Holiday list they had did not contain September 11, 2021 to be used for a staff holiday since the staff works the July 4th holiday due to the Community Carnival. A motion to accept the added holiday was made by Mayor Craig Bryant with a second for Councilmember Christopher Witt. The motion carried with a vote of 5-0. Mayor Craig Bryant then read a Proclamation allowing Santa to deliver toys during the Governor's stay at home order from the hours of midnight and 5AM as this is when he is scheduled to deliver in the town of Buchanan. A motion to accept was made by Vice Mayor James Manspile with a second from Councilmember Marlon Rickman. The motion carried with a vote of 5-0. Then Mayor Craig Bryant asked the children in the audience if they would vote as well. The motion carried with a resounding "Yes!" from the audience.

The next item of business was to hear Committee Reports. For the Special Events Committee, Marlon Rickman stated that he had heard a lot of compliments on the Festival of Lights. Donations from those that drove through totaled \$2417.82. He also stated that plans were being made for 2021 Community Carnival in hopes it can be done. Christmas Eve Luminaries will be done and Harry Gleason is in contact with the Health Department as to the safest way to put them out. Councilmember Rickman also thanked Jackson Tyree for all the help he gives to the events. For the Planning Commission, Councilman Chris Witt had nothing new to report at this time. Next, for the Community and Economic Development Committee, Councilmember John Mays thanked Council for accepting the resolution for the signage because he felt that it may attract a larger scale restaurant or business. Next, for the Public Works Committee, Vice Mayor James Manspile reported there had been 11 Miss Utilities and stated that a project that would take place before the end of the year would be a sewer repair that would require cutting into a sidewalk. Vice Mayor James Manspile also brought grease in the pipes to the attention of Council as the reason many sewer repairs were being done. Also, VDOT will be looking at the route 11 bridge for repairs sometime between January and March of 2021 with repairs being done in April 2021. Councilmember Chris Witt stated that there had been complaints of bird waste on the swinging bridge

making it a walking hazard. Town Manager Jason Tyree stated that he would contact VDOT about how to safely clean the bridge without harming the structure.

Next, was Citizen Comments on Non-Agenda Items. No citizens were signed up to speak.

Mayor Craig Bryant stated that they were moving forward with a COVID-19 vaccine and as a town we can help citizens by hosting a vaccination clinic, have appropriate information on our town website and educate town staff on how and where to direct questions. Town Manager Jason Tyree thanked staff for a good 2020.

With no further discussion, a motion for adjournment was made by Vice-Mayor James Manspile. The motion was seconded by Councilman John Mays. The motion to adjourn passed with a vote of 5-0. The meeting was adjourned at 7:51p.m.

Mayor Craig Bryant opened the November 18, 2020 Council work session at 7:00 p.m. Town Manager Jason Tyree took roll call with all Councilmembers present.

First on the Agenda was discussion of using CARES Act funding to repair/replace the HVAC System at the Fire Department. Funds have to be spent by December 31, 2020 and Town Manager Jason Tyree asked Council to allow him to sign off on the funding before a council meeting to lock in the funds. Mayor Craig Bryant stated that he would ask for a signed letter that states if the CARES Act funding did not cover the expense that the County would pay for it. Town Manager Jason Tyree said he had verbal agreement, but would require the County to sign with intent to cover the cost if the funding is not approved. Mayor Bryant also voiced his displeasure over some of the items that were denied by the CARES Act funding such as showers for the employees in case of contamination. Town Manager Jason Tyree stated that the Public Works employees had a change of clothing and access to a shower at the Sewage Treatment Plant if needed. Mayor Bryant asked about part-time employees and Town Manager Jason Tyree said that they would be asked to have a change of clothes and they would have access to the shower facility at the Sewage Treatment Plant. Mayor Bryant and Vice Mayor Manspile stated that they did not feel that all of the information about services from the CARES Act was being communicated from a local level. They feared that businesses were not informed as well as they should be about what options they had. Councilmember John Mays stated that every time Harry Gleason receives new information, he sends an email to the local businesses and copies it to the chair of the Economic Development Committee. Mayor Craig Bryant asked the Town Manager Jason Tyree for a rundown off all items purchased with the CARES Act funds. Town Manager Jason Tyree stated he would have one to present at the December Council Meeting.

Next on the Agenda was discussion of COVID-19 Town Events. Harry Gleason is working with the Health Department on how the town can continue drive thru events. So far, drive thru events have been

approved. Council discussed the tree lighting and whether it would be virtual or just turn the lights on the day after Thanksgiving. After discussion, it was decided to just turn lights on the day after Thanksgiving due to any advertisement of the lighting would bring a crowd. Nest was the discussion of Christmas Lights on Main Street. The wreaths presently put up are older and in need of replacement. Councilmember John Mays stated that he would like to see lights strung across the streets, but with it being an I-81 corridor Councilmember Chris Witt and Vice Mayor James Manspile stated that the large trucks wouldn't have clearance. Vice Mayor James Manspile stated that with the huge success of fundraising Harry Gleason accomplished for the Festival of Lights, that he would like him to head up a group to replace the Main Street Christmas Lights. Council was in agreement.

Town Manager Jason Tyree spoke about the planning of the annual Council Retreat to be held at Town Hall Saturday, January 2, 2021 from 9AM to 12PM. This retreat is to review the rules and regulations of serving on council and representing the Town of Buchanan. All council was in agreement of the date. Next was the discussion of the Town of Buchanan holidays. Mayor Craig Bryant stated that he felt that the town staff missed out on the July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday due to the Community Carnival and that Council coould offer another day to replace it. His suggestion was September 11<sup>th</sup> also known as Patriot's Day. Council was in agreement to replace the day. Then have a drawing at Town Hall during Council meeting with a deputy present. He also stated that the town needed to look into larger items to boost ticket sales.

Council then went into Closed Session at 8:10PM.

#### A RESOLUTION

IMPLEMENTING OF RULES OF CONDUCT FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARINGS DURING TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, by the Council of the Town of Buchanan, Virginia, as follows:

The rules of conduct for Town of Buchanan regular and special meetings shall be:

- 1. Except for public hearings designated as such by action of the Town Council, public participation at meetings of the Town Council shall be limited to the public comment segments of the agenda of regular Town Council meetings or special meetings.
- 2. Any requests for Town Council action must be presented to the Mayor or Town Manager at least 30 days in advance of the next regular scheduled Town Council meeting. Any request received within 30 days of the next regular Town Council meeting may be held until the following regularly scheduled Town Council meeting. Town Council reserves the right to not act on any actions requested until proper vetting is completed and all information is obtained in order to facilitate an informed and appropriate decision.
- 3. A speakers comments shall be limited to three (3) minutes per person, for all agenda items and non-agenda items. Provided the Mayor may give additional time for special circumstances or good cause. An individual's time may not be given or traded to other speakers or reserved for other portions of the meeting. The Town Manager or designee shall act as timekeeper or Town Council shall designate another elected officer as timekeeper. Each speaker will be signaled when his or her time has elapsed.

- 4. Any person wishing to speak at a public hearing must sign the appropriate "sign-in sheet" upon entering the room before the start of the meeting, indicating his or her intention to speak, which sheet shall be used by the Mayor, Vice-Mayor, or other Town Council member to recognize speakers. Any person wishing to speak at a public meeting during the public comment segments or during a public hearing, when a sign-in sheet is not available, shall raise his or her hand. When recognized by the Mayor, Vice-Mayor, or other Town Council member, the individual must stand and state his or her name, address, and, if appropriate, group affiliation and must state the subject he or she will be addressing.
- 5. A public hearing is conducted to receive comments from interested parties relating to the purpose of the public hearing. Town Council will not engage in dialogue with speakers during public hearings or public comment.
- 6. Members of the Town Council, speakers, and audience must observe proper decorum. Any statement made during the meeting or during a public hearing by the Mayor, members of the Town Council, or town employees or members of the public shall not involve personal, disrespectful, or slanderous attacks on individuals, regardless of whether the individual attacked is an elected official, or town employee or a member of the public.
- 7. The Mayor or the presiding officer shall control the meeting. The use of profane, vulgar, inflammatory, threatening, abusive or disparaging language, or racial or ethnic slur shall not be tolerated. All attendees must be respectful to others present.
- 8. Discussion between speakers and attendees of the public meeting or hearing are prohibited. A speaker may disagree with or support prior speakers in comments directed to the Town Council. No person attending a meeting or public hearing shall engage in booing, handclapping or otherwise disrupt the formality of the proceedings.
- 9. Banners, flyers or other signs are not permitted in the Council Chambers. Distribution of flyers in the meeting room is also not permitted.
- 10. All cell phones and pagers must be turned off or muted.
- 11. Attendees when leaving the council meeting before it is adjourned must leave in a quiet and orderly manner until outside the meeting room and hallway, so as not to disrupt the meeting.

- 12. If the Mayor or presiding officer fails to enforce the rules set forth herein, a member of the Town Council may; move to require him or her to do so, and an affirmative vote of a majority of the Town Council shall require him or her to do so. Any decision relating to enforcement of the rules set forth herein may be appealed and overturned by a vote of a majority of the Town Council members.
- 13. Any person who disregards the directives of the Mayor or residing officer in enforcing the rules or generally conducts himself or herself in a boisterous or inappropriate manner while addressing the Town Council or otherwise during a meeting disturbs the peace at a meeting may be barred from further participation at future meetings and lose any balance of time remaining for his or her comment.
- 14. If a speaker who violates these rules refuses to step down, the Mayor or the presiding officer may ask the individual to be removed from the Council Chambers.
